

During part of this time he was ill with giver in a Hospifal. When the armies were reorganised in Egypt he was fransperred into the 15th Field ambulance, but owing to his illness was unable to leave for Thance with his unit. He then joined the 4th Irsining Battalion, and left with this Battalion for England in June. 1916. Le is now, on Fallsbury Placers, and when last heard from was well.
