Enlisting 23rd August, 1915, and sailing 1st May, 1916, with 9th Australian Field Ambulance, arrived at Armentières in November and served continuously through Messines, Warneton, Ypres and Passchendaele as a stretcher-bearer until wounded at Villers-Bretonneux 4th April, 1918. After seven months in Canadian Hospital, Taplow, Dartford Hospital and camps in England, returned to France just before the Armistice and served until demobilisation.
