My war service was that of a Chaplain A.I.F. I embarked in September 1916 and served on transports, Military Camps at Sutton Veny England, with the 1st Brigade (being attached to the 1st Infantry Battalion) in France. Later I was Chaplain of the 1st Australian General Hospital and took my discharge in England in September 1919 when I went to Oxford University where I graduated.

If you think the above warrants it I should be glad to have my name included on the Adelaide University Honour Roll.

I am at present Chaplain of the 10th/50th Battalion C.M.F.
