On recovery joined 3rd Cov., A.A.S.C. 4th December and served on Tripoli frontier until March, 1916, and returning to Australia in July, was discharged 4th August to resume medical studies. Reenlisting 31st October and sailing with 25th Reinforcements 3rd Battn. in November, 1917, joined battn. 4th April and fought in Hazebrouck and Somme sectors, being wounded at Proyart, 23rd August and, rejoining battn. on recovery, served until demobilisation.
