Re-enlisting and sailing 29th December, 1917, after resuming duty as Senior Chaplain (Presbyterian), 1st (Queensland) Military District for twelve months, served at No. 3 Australian Auxiliary Hospital, Dartford, from 21st March to 25th April, 1918, and then at H.Q., Tidworth, till 4th July. Crossing to France, was at Australian Infantry Base Depot, Rouelles, till appointed to 2nd Divisional Troops, attached to 5th Artillery Brigade 26th October, remaining with them until demobilisation.
