Regt. at Gallipoli till the Evacuation and then in Palestine till invalided. After convalescence was sent to No. I Australian Dermatological Hospital, Bulford, later to No. I A.G.H., Rouen, for three months and then to 14th Australian Field Ambulance, serving on the Somme and elsewhere, becoming second in command prior to demobilisation.
