Get away by simply asking
is impossible. I could not put forward any reason other
than my own personal feelings. If I have heard that
an official intimation that the University or the Hospital
wishes me - desired my return, then I could go to the A.M.C.
with something definite. He would perhaps refer it to

be dealt with. As it is without some real guarantee
no one can get out of the service. Until a few months
ago each member of the medical service - had the
best of chances of returning say after 12 months service.
In fact I know that many notices were sent out

send in their names &c. This was withdrawn and
I understand that notice was sent round stating
that no one of the A.M.C. was to return until after

I didn't sign on for 17 months only. Do you see how I am
situated - but I have been idle. I have very easily
work. I'm digging away into the French language
and I have hope of being transferred to work with A.E. Wright

and asked him what I was doing. He replied asking
