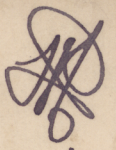

Enlisted 11th August 1914 - private - Sailed 17th August 1914 to German New Guinea in the "Benalla" - promoted to Corporal September 1914 Returned to Australia February 1915 commissioned as Second Lieutenant, arrived Gallipoli 1915 and remained until Armistice. ^{Evac}Service in Egypt March 1916 - promoted Captain May 1916. Remained with unit until May 1917 - invalided to Australia October 1917. Remobilised with Censorship Department 1918.
