Full details and remarks as to service:— *Enlisted 2nd September 1915. Left Sydney March 29th 1916, Staged at Tel-el-Kebir for a month, went to England and formed details (A.M.C) on Salisbury plains. Left for France August 16th 1916 and attached to 8th Field Amb. at Estaires, Remained there as stretcher bearer till finish of the War. Carried in every engagement with 5th Aust Division also with the whole Corps, At Armentieres Sep 1916. Somme before Bapaume Oct to March 16/17 Bapaume to Bullcourt April May 17. Gassed Sep-Oct 17. Messines Nov-Feb 17-18. Amiens to Villers-Bretonneux April to Aug 18 Villers Bret to Bellcourt Aug-Sep 18. Attached to Battalions as bearer from August 1918. Twice gassed at Gassed 4 Villers-Bret, Wounded at persone. Evacuated to 3rd A.G.H. Abbeville with influenza Nov-18 Rejoined unit Christmas 18. Spent the remaining 3 months hospital duties nursing Soldiers and Civilians at Sars-poteries (France) and Erguulines (Belgium). Left for England April 19th 19. Spent three months in Camp there. Sailed for Australia 16 June Arrived 6th August 19*
