C.M.G., D.S.O., V.D., M.R.C.S., Lecturer in First Aid: Brigadier-General, A.A.M.C., A.I.F., Gallipoli, Egypt and France.

Forming 5th Australian Field Ambulance in March, 1915, and sailing with it, reached Gallipoli in August and remained in command until the Evacuation. On 5th February, 1916, was promoted colonel, appointed D.D.M.S. II Anzac Corps and served with it for five months in Egypt and four in France, where responsible for medical arrangements at Battle of Fleurbaix, till invalided to Australia, arriving in December. Made a C.M.G. 4th June, 1917, and Mentioned in Despatches.

Died of Illness due to War Service, Noumea, 3rd September, 1924, and was buried there.
