February 1916 promoted Lieutenant Colonel & appointed to command 9th Field Ambulance, A.F.F. Raised & took it overseas c 3rd Division. In France at Arras, Ploegsteert, Messines, Warneton, Passchendaele, 1916-1917. Jan. 1918. promoted Colonel & appointed Assistant Director of Medical Services, 3rd Australian Division which appointment was held till demobilisation in April 1920. Served in France 1916-1919.
