Total service 3 years 316 days.
Enlisting in 1915 I went away with 9th Field Ambulance under Col. Maguire. F.S.O., being attached to a new Division namely, the 3rd Australian Division, we had to spend about 6 months in England training. In France I was with the Unit at Armentieres, Messines, Ypres etc (1917) and the final engagements from Villiers Bretonneux.

During my wanderings around the Somme I visited Amiens Cathedral, and like most Australians I secured a souvenir in the form of glass from the old stained windows of the Amiens Cathedral. I have collected such things as a museum and would be pleased to donate some.
