Enlisting 1st May, 1915, was appointed R.M.O. 19th Battn. and, sailing 25th June, served for a short period with Engineers and from 4th November with 8th Battn. in Gallipoli, Egypt and France till wounded at Pozières 12th August, 1916. Buried by a shell and again wounded 20th September, 1917, at Menin Road, was some weeks in hospital in France and England. On recovery rejoined battn., refusing Base Hospital appointment and transferred to 2nd Australian Field Ambulance 22nd June, 1918, and to 3rd on 31st August, being demobilised in England 24th August, 1920, and returning to Australia
