Enlisting 25th September, 1916, and sailing 9th November, served in A.I.F. depots in United Kingdom from January to March, 1917, and at Base Hospital, Rouen, till May. Was R.M.O. 46th Battn. from June to August and joined 12th Australian Field Ambulance in September, being R.M.O. 12th Artillery Brigade from October, 1917, to October, 1918, and with 4th A.F. Amb. from November, 1918, to March, 1919. Awarded M.C.* and Mentioned in Despatches.
