Crossing from Egypt to France in June with 14th Australian Field Ambulance, was present at all engagements until the end of 1918, when appointed D.A.D.M.S. 5th Division, serving until demobilisation. Promoted major, 20th June, 1917. Awarded M.C.\* for work on 22nd December, 1916.
