Enlisted in Kitcheners Army as an Engineer in the Mechanical Transport section of the ^{21st Div. HQ Staff} R.A.S.C. 3/3/1915. Was on active service at Loos & Armentieres during the whole time abroad. Was "Assisting Engineer" during the outward voyage on a Troopship bringing Australian Soldiers back to Australia about the end of 1916.
