I. F. He arrived in England on 14th September 1914, and he is now at Salisbury Plains, England. He was 20 years of age on the 3rd October last.

Prior to enlisting he was articled to the firm of Messrs von Bertouch & Vaughan, Solicitors, Adelaide, and had entered the University as an undergraduate in the L.L.B., course. He took part in sports side of University life, and was an active member of the lacrosse, and rowing clubs.
