Returning to 6th A.F.Amb. 4th April, 1918, was gassed at Morritt Wood, Somme, 30th May and again at Hamel, whence evacuated to England and Australia, arriving in February, 1919, being torpedoed on hospital ship "Wandilla" while crossing the Channel 3rd August.
