until March 1916. Since then he has been in  
France with his Battalion. Has been slightly  
wounded twice. Is at the last time of hearing  
from him, in Hospital at Epsom in England  
under a Pathologist, suffering from an outbreak  
of boils on his back, after the battle at  
Poynes
