

## **NOWLAND, REGINALD EDWARD.**

M.C., M.B. : Captain, A.A.M.C., A.I.F., England and France.

Enlisting 14th May, 1917, and sailing 16th June, served as R.M.O. 5th Training Battrn., Fovant. Crossing to France, joined No. 2 Australian General Hospital, Wimereux, whence detached for duty with 107th Field Ambulance, becoming R.M.O. 157th Field Artillery Brigade. Late in 1918 transferred to 5th A.F.Amb., serving until demobilisation. Awarded M.C.\* for work while with British Artillery.
