Enlisting 6th July, 1916, and sailing on 19th, was at No. 2. Australian General Hospital, Wimereux, from early 1917 until invalided to England—Hon. Mrs. Acland's Hospital, Welwyn. After returning to No. 2 A.G.H., went to No. 2 Canadian Casualty Clearing Station, Remy Siding, as anæsthetist to a surgical team. Then joining 14th Australian Field Ambulance, was subsequently appointed R.M.O. 54th Battn. at Villers-Bretonneux during its first attack, remaining with it until demobilisation.
