Full details and remarks as to service:—

Left Sydney by the 'Curupedes' with June Reinforcements Field Engineers and arrived at Plymouth towards the end of December. On arrival, I transferred to 13th Batta. & after training for about 2 months at Bodford, England went to France & joined up with the Batta. I was with them continually until July 4th when I was wounded in the left arm at Hamel & was sent to Rouen to 4th General American Hospital & later to Beaufort Hospital Bristol, England. From Bristol I went to Sandil Hospital Stonehouse & then to Weymouth. The armistice was declared while I was at Weymouth & I left for Australia by the 'Nestor' from Liverpool. On arrival here I spent 7 months at Rowdwick Hospital receiving massage treatment & was discharged about October 1919.
