Was M.O. Australian Railway Coys. at Havre and Codford prior to return for demobilisation.

Medical Superintendent, Rosemount Repatriation Hospital. R.A.N.R.: Surgeon-Lieutenant-Commander, 1930. Early education at Sydney Grammar School.
