Enlisting 12th January, 1915, was commissioned in November and sailing 15th January, 1916, with 14th Reinforcements, crossed from Egypt to France in March and was temporarily assistant Q.M. to Battn. and later to 1st Division at Base. Served at the Somme, Ypres, Meteren, Strazeele and elsewhere until demobilisation, although invalided to hospital in February and May, 1917. Awarded M.C.* for work at Gutzer Farm, Strazeele.
