My son matriculated from the Brisbane Grammar School, & entered Sydney University in 1909, graduating in medicine in 1914, during the latter part of which year he held the position of Radiographer at Sydney Hospital.

In 1915 he entered Brisbane General Hospital as resident medical officer & at the time of his enlistment was assistant to Dr. R. A. Meek of South Brisbane.

My son joined the A. I. F. in September 1916 & left Australia in May 1917

He is at present in France where he has been for
some months attached as Regimental Medical Officer
to the 41st Infantry Battalion
