Enlisting in September, 1914, with Inns of Court Officers Training Corps, was gazetted in December and, crossing to France in January, 1916, joined 56th Division about May, being seconded as O.C. 169th Trench Mortar Battery and serving till shell-shocked 30th June and evacuated to England. Returning to unit in September, 1917, was gassed in December, again evacuated to England and in 1918 granted leave to Australia, where posted to Home Defence until demobilisation.
