He left Melbourne on the 25th
October in the transport Ulysses. We have had
two letters from him. He stated that he was not
allowed to state his whereabouts, but we suspect
he went through the Suez Canal. He is a signaller,
but left as a gunner attached to the 23rd F. A. B.
(7th Reinforcements). The 23rd are at present in
France. He was in good health when the letters
were written, the last one having been penned on
November 6th. He says he is very fit, and determined
to do any duty assigned to him, trusting in God to
bring him safely through. If there is anything else
you would like to know I shall be pleased to let you
know by phone.
