Memo. of 4th Inst. I have great pleasure
in giving you particulars in respect
to my dear son Mr A. G. Maddox

He left here on the 27th October last year,
spent 5 months in Egypt including some
two or three months in the Desert and
took part in expelling the Turks. He
was then sent to France, and has been
in three engagements against the
Bosches, being ^{WIP} wounded in the fight at
Mouquet Farm and sent to No 1 General
Hospital in London, and has been in a
Convalescent Hospital. In his last
letter he says he expects to leave the latter
place in a few days and intended taking
a trip to Scotland. Although his

wounds were serious, I am thankful
to hear that he is progressing favor-
-ably and is feeling well, and having
a good time ^{with} friends, and sight seeing,
but does not anticipate being sent
to the front for some time. He went
away from here as a private.
