In reply to your circular of 4<sup>th</sup> inst  
I have to inform you that 'At the commencement  
of the War my own name as you are aware  
was dropped' but after the Declaration he in  
common with many others from that  
Institution enlisted - He joined the R.A.M.  
and was for some months in Camp at Seelbush  
Plain and elsewhere in England. He was  
then ordered to India to take charge of a  
Hospital at Bangalore where he still is.  
His present rank is that of Captain

A regiment (the Scouts) are camped  
about 5 miles from Bangalore and he  
has to go out there every day.
