On recovery transferred to 12th Regt., was wounded again at Semak, Tiberias Lake (Sea of Galilee) 25th September and invalided to Port Said, Cairo, and finally to Australia by hospital ship, arriving in May, 1919. Discharged from Randwick 23rd April, 1920, but readmitted in May to military ward in Royal Prince Alfred Hospital and finally discharged in December.
