Transferring to 5th Divisional Supply Column (later 5th A.M.T.), though never actually with that unit, was on its strength while attached to 8th A.F.Amb. as driver. After sickness in March, 1918, returned to 15th A.F.Amb. in July, remaining there until demobilisation.
