


Miss Greta Towner, Harry Maloney Wed Here

Announcement of the marriage of Miss Greta Norman Towner and Harry Maloney, former director of minor sports at Stanford University, was made yesterday. The ceremony was performed by Rev. Brewster Adams on February 10 at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Lester D. Summerfield and was followed by an informal reception for a few close friends.

Mrs. Maloney was born at Queensland, Australia, and is the daughter of Mrs. Edgar L. Towner. She was a first lieutenant in the Australian army nurse corps during the first world war and saw foreign service in Egypt and France. She has made her home in San Francisco for the past twenty-four years, where she was employed by the veterans' administration. Mr. Maloney was connected with Stanford University for many years and recently came to Reno to reside.

### Comment

In 1921, the Rockhampton *Morning Bulletin* reported Miss G.N Towner was moving to Colorado, USA. In 1924, the *Brisbane Courier* sees her marrying Harold Pascoe, who was dentist in San Francisco. Research by Margaret Doherty shows the marriage does not last.

The article from Reno, California sees her marrying in 1945, Harry Maloney, a university coach from Stanford University. Greta Towner is now in her mid-50s and her new husband is 12 years her senior.

The border crossing record tells us something of both Harry and Greta, it shows them arriving in Canada on a ship from Australia in 1946, indicating a visit home by Greta after the marriage. Closer inspection shows that both Harry and Greta became naturalised citizens of the United States of America – Greta on January 22<sup>nd</sup> 1925 (one year after her marriage to Harold Pascoe) and Harry Maloney on 6<sup>th</sup> January 1910.

Greta's name is recorded as "Greta Towner Maloney" – she has kept her identity in some way whilst taking on the convention of the day of using a husband's surname.

Where and what was Greta doing from 1924 to 1945? Initial searches through Ancestry.com Voter Registration records show Greta Towner listing her occupation as nurse in 1930, 1940 and 1944 she is listed as being employed at the US Veterans Hospital, Livermore, as nurse. San Francisco Directories show her listed as Greta N Towner, with a 1933 edition recording her as "Towner Greta N nurse Vets Admn Facility".

Greta reverting to her family name after her marriage to Harold Pascoe indicates a woman with a sense of identity. The 1930 voter registration sees her as Greta Towner, so her marriage must have ended by then. It would appear that Greta Towner had the means to support herself and create a new life as a single woman, far from her home town of Blackall in Central Western Queensland. For a nurse who started her career at the Rockhampton Children's hospital, her chosen career working with veterans in the USA is interesting, her war experiences must have instilled a deep connection with caring for servicemen. Just as service in the war changed some men, it appears in Greta's case it changed her, setting her life on a different path – especially to those of her siblings, who all remained in Australia.
