Crossing to France 24th November, was attached for a time to 2nd Australian Tunnelling Coy. but, rejoining battn. 4th February, 1917, was wounded at Armentières on 19th. After six months in hospital, being unfit, was transferred to No. 3 Australian Auxiliary Hospital, Dartford, doing duty in theatre, surgical supplies and massage (hand and electrical) and returning to Australia 2nd June, 1918.
